



INVITATION TO THE PUBLIC TO NOMINATE POTENTIAL HERITAGE RESOURCES IN THE WESTERN CAPE, WORTHY OF PROVINCIAL HERITAGE STATUS TO FORM PART OF THE NATIONAL ESTATE IN TERMS OF SECTION 3(2) OF THE HERITAGE RESOURCE ACT, 25 OF 1999.

1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND:

Heritage Western Cape (HWC) is embarking on a project to give the public the opportunity to identify and nominate sites in the Western Cape Province having aesthetic, architectural, historical, scientific, social, spiritual, linguistic or technological heritage significance worthy of Provincial Heritage Site (PHS) status.

2. OBJECTIVE:

To give the public an opportunity each year to identify and record sites within the Western Cape Province, worthy of being proclaimed as a PHS in terms of Section 27 of the National Heritage Resources Act (NHRA). These sites should encapsulate the criteria mentioned above. The nomination form can be found on the HWC website (www.hwc.org.za). The nomination form should be submitted to HWC for assessment and approval by its relevant Committees and Council.

3. NOMINATION APPLICATION MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

The nomination form should be filled in to the best of the nominators' ability and knowledge where possible, including but not limited to the following must be submitted:

- Erf number, street address and all relevant information of such potential site.
- Up to date photographs of the potential site being put forth for PHS.
- Owners' name and contact details of such potential site.
- The contact details of any other parties who may have an interest in such potential site.
- Historical research about such potential site and its heritage significance in terms of the above criteria.

4. REQUIREMENTS

- The nominator should be able to provide further information about the potential site where possible, should HWC require further information.
- The nominator should attend meetings, if possible where such nomination will be tabled for endorsement and approval.

5. TIMEFRAMES:

- The closing date for submissions of nominations is at close of business on 15 April 2021.
